 RE: 2019 Underclassmen Exam Schedule

Students who do not have an exam on exam days and have fulfilled all of their student obligations do not have to attend school on these days. All books must be returned on exam day before taking the exam.

The end-of-year examination schedule will be as follows:

On Monday, June 10, students should report to homeroom for attendance. It is a day 8. This is a full day of school with a Bulldog Block. We will utilize the following schedule:

If a student does not have a final exam on June 10, they are able to be picked up after block 2. If a student has a block 3 exam and no block 4 exam, they can be picked up after block 3. If a student only has an exam during block 4, they will report to first lunch and then to the auditorium for block 3. Bus pickup will be 2:05 p.m. If a student is in the building without an exam, they are to report to the auditorium until 2:03 p.m.

All students are expected to take their final exams when the final exams are scheduled. No student will be permitted to take an exam early without prior approval of the principal. Make-up exams are given for EMERGENCY reasons only. Approval to make up an exam must be in writing from an administrator. Exams are designed for the entire block and all students must remain in their classroom for the entire block. Students will not be admitted to exams late. If a student arrives after the designated start time (7:37 A.M. or 8:57 A.M.), they will receive a 0.

It is imperative that students who have received an attendance “No-Credit” letter submit their appeal letter to Mr. Barrasso by Tuesday, May 21, 2019.

On Friday, June 7, homeroom will be extended until 7:45 for locker clean out. Students are expected to clean out their assigned locker and remove all stickers and markings. Extra trash barrels and bags will be available. Permanent damage to a locker (including markings) must be reported in writing to Mr. Barrasso by noon on June 10. Please remember to include the student’s name and locker number. Students who have accumulated a lot of “stuff” should consider beginning the locker clean out process earlier.

The last three days of school (exam days) will be half days for students. On June 11, 12, and 13 buses will leave the high school at 10:20 a.m. The routes for these buses will be posted in the classrooms, in the front office and on-line. On Friday, June 14, the usual buses will leave at 11:30 A.M., as this is dismissal time for the Junior High School. The last day of late busses (3:30 P.M) will be June 6.
